committee or subcommittee to express their interest.

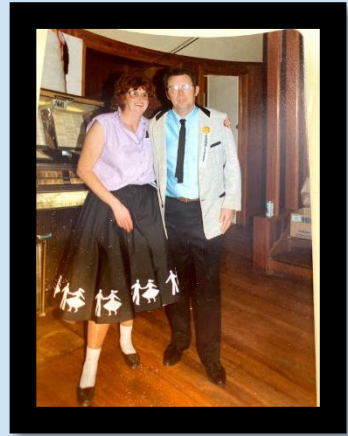

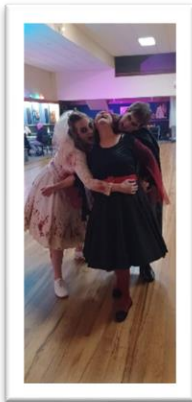
November dance music will be provided by DJ, so come along thinking about your favourite song you can request.

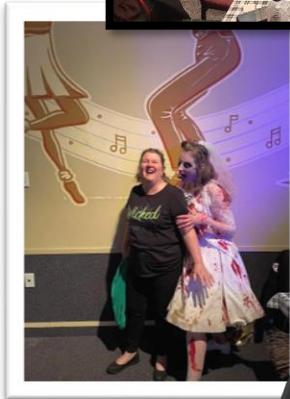
