There are still some outstanding subs. If you intend to continue as a Club member, please pay promptly

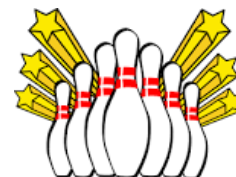
Curling
